1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Albury-Wodonga Motorcycle Club, hereinafter called the PROMOTER, will conduct the 2017 Victorian Senior Speedway Solo Championships at Diamond Park Speedway, Lincoln Causeway, Wodonga on Saturday 16th December 2016 (Rain Date Sunday 17th December 2017).

2. JURISDICTION

The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Victoria (MV) and will be held in accordance with the General Competition Rules (GCR's) of Motorcycling Australia (MA), the by-laws of MV, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued by the stewards of the meeting.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted forthwith from current MA Senior National (SNA) and MA Junior National (JNA) competition licence holders. Current competition licence and current club membership card must be produced at sign in. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Entry Fee for the Senior Speedway Solo Championship will be \$30 (which includes the \$12 Rider Levy payable to Motorcycling Victoria)

Entries for this event can only be completed on-line at www.motorcyclingvic.com.au at the Speedway Section on the web site.

All Entry Fees will be payable in cash (not cheques) at Sign On on 16th December 2017.

NOTE: Entries close on Wednesday 6th December 2017.

4. ADMISSION FEES

Admission fees to the event will be as follows:

Adults: \$15 per person
Pensioners: \$10 per person
Children 12-U16: \$5
Family Pass: \$40 (parents & children)
Children under 12 years are free.

Each entry will entitle admission of the Rider and one Mechanic for free. All other attendees will be required to pay admission. Wrist bands will be issued for the Rider and two licensed Mechanics at sign-on.

5. MEDICAL SERVICES

St Johns Ambulance will be in attendance for the entirety of the event.

6. SIGN IN

Sign in for the abovementioned event will take place from 4pm to 5:30pm on 16th December 2017.

7. RIDERS BRIEFING

Attendance at the Riders Briefing is compulsory. The Riders Briefing for all classes will take place at 6:45pm on 16th December 2017.

8. TEMPORARY GUARDIAN

Riders under the age of 18, if not accompanied by parents, must have a guardianship form filled out prior to the event and presented at sign in. The guardian must be over 18 years and have ID.

9. MACHINE EXAMINATION

All machines must comply with the 2017 GCR's. Machine examination will take place from 4.30pm until 6.00pm for all classes on 16th December 2017.

10. RACE FORMAT

10.1 The Championship Meeting will be conducted over twenty (20) heats, with two Semi Finals and one Championship Final with four riders in each race.

10.2 All races will be over four (4) laps.

10.3 FINALS

SEMI FINAL 1

The 1st, 4th, 6th and 7th point scorers will go into Semi Final 1. The 1st and 2nd riders from this race will go to the Championship Final.

SEMI FINAL 2

The 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 8th point scorers will go into Semi Final 2. The 1st and 2nd riders from this race will go to the Championship Final.

CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL

The placings in this final will determine who are 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in the Championship.

10.4 If riders are tied on points for the semi finals the count back system will be used.

10.5 The Championship format may be changed if insufficient entries are received to conduct a 20 heat format.

10.6 SUPPORT CLASSES

The support classes for the meeting will be Veterans / B Grade Speedway Solo (5 rider maximum x 5 heats) and Pro 450cc Short Track (8 riders maximum x 5 heats).

11. AWARDS

For the Senior Solo Championship

\$30 per point will be paid for the twenty heats.

No point money or awards will be provided for the B Final.

Bonus money will be 1st \$500, 2nd \$300, 3rd \$200, 4th \$100.

Trophies and sashes will be presented to the four place getters in the A Final.

No tow money will be paid for the event.

Points for both meetings will be 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1 point, 4th 0 points.

Non finishers will receive one of the following notations alongside their name on the score sheet:

M (excluded due to 2 minute rule)

R (retired from race)

F (fall but not excluded)

T (excluded for false start)

D (excluded)

N (non starter)

12. CAMPING

Camping at the venue is permitted. Hot showers are available.

A full canteen service will operate from 4:00pm for the entirety of the event.

13. CODE OF CONDUCT

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law – CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behavior at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced.

15. VENUE DESCRIPTION

Senior track length is 350 metres
Track surface is Decomposed Granite

GENERAL

1. **Noise:** Noise emissions must comply with the relevant sections of the *2017 Manual of Motorcycle Sport*.
 2. **Riding Numbers / Starting Positions** – will be drawn and allocated by Motorcycling Victoria.
 3. **Riding of Motorcycles:** The riding of any competing motorcycles in the pits or car park or camping area is not permitted. Infringing riders will be brought before the stewards of the meeting. Any offender may be fined \$50.00, which must be paid before any further participation is permitted. No pit bikes or non - competing motorcycles are permitted to be ridden at any time at the venue.
 4. **No Hassle Policy:** Any rider, entrant or person associated with a rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner in any dealings whatsoever, with any official of the meeting. A rider shall be responsible for his/her own conduct and that of any person with whom he/she is associated who abuses or threatens in any manner, either verbally or physically, any official. Penalties, which may be imposed by the stewards for breach, include reprimand or warning. Minimum \$50.00 fine or exclusion from the meeting.
 5. **Abandonment:** In the event of the meeting being abandoned due to circumstances beyond the control of the promoters before racing commences, entry fees will be returned, less a fee per entry to cover administration costs. Once the competition has commenced only the stewards of the meeting have the authority to abandon the meeting and their decision shall be final. In such cases the stewards will rule on the results according to the circumstances.
 6. **Facilities:** Full canteen facilities will be available for the duration of the event and showers are available after the event.
 7. **Bicycles:** Bicycles are not permitted in the pits or on the racing circuit. No Pit Bikes will be allowed anywhere at this complex.
 8. **Animals:** Are not permitted into the grounds. Seeing Eye dogs are permitted.
 9. **Motorcycles:** Are to be kept in the pit area at all times when not being used for competition. Unless permission to remove the motorcycle has been granted by the stewards of the meeting. Any motorcycle removed from the pit area without permission of the stewards, will be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition.
 10. **Reservations:** The Stewards of the meeting reserve the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the events program.
 11. **Unauthorised:** Persons are prohibited from entering the track infield area. Such unauthorised persons will be removed from prohibited areas.
 12. **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RIDERS/ENTRANTS/PARENTS/GUARDIANS: CAPITAL BENEFITS INSURANCE IS APPLICABLE TO ALL RIDERS WITH A CURRENT LICENCE.**
It is conditional upon acceptance of this entry that it is fully understood by the rider/entrant/parent/guardian to arrange personal injury and ambulance transportation insurance cover in case you should require the same during the running of this competition.
