Sign on:

Sign on will be completed in a paper-less process. All riders have signed the indemnity on entry to the event. If you are under 18 years of age, please bring your parent/guardian to sign on. Please make sure you have your licence with you at sign on.

Scrutineering – Please DO NOT bring a paper form to sign on with you. If you have not completed the form prior, your bike will be manually scrutineered, please bring your bike to sign on with you. (Please ensure your handlebars have pads). Before and throughout the event a Scrutineer will conduct random spot checks, on bikes and riding safety gear – in this instance riders will not be permitted to enter the track until the scrutineer has passed any faults, racing will not be delayed.



PIT AREA

Closed Pits will operate for both days. Remember you cannot take your bike out of the pit area after it enters unless authorised by the Clerk of Course or their assistant.

A reminder to riders and support crew that open footwear including thongs are not permitted in the pit area. Children under 12yo must always be supervised and be with an adult. As the event also includes juniors there is NO smoking at the venue as per State Law.

ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE A MIN 1KG FIRE EXTINGUISHER AVAILABLE TO THEM IN THEIR PIT. FIRE EXTINGUISHER MUST SUIT YOUR BIKE (ELECTRICAL TYPE FOR ELECTRIC BIKES). IF SHARING A PIT TENT WITH ANOTHER RIDER THERE MUST BE AT LEAST 1 FIRE EXTINGUISHER PER TENT.

****No BBQs. Gas Burners or similar to be lit in the pits****

Walking of Tracks:

ALL RIDERS may walk the track after 12 Noon Friday. Riders may walk Sunday's tracks half an hour after completion of racing on Saturday (Saturday's Podium placed riders will be required for interviews **prior to walking tracks**).

Rider Number and Plate Colours:

As per the supplementary regulations, all riders MUST use their allocated Victorian number or their allocated National number, if you are using your National number please put the letter A at the end of the number to represent it is a national number. The letter A is only required to be ¼ size of your race number on the front number plate. All number plates on all machines MUST comply with GCR 10.12.1.5.

Spectators:

Entry beyond the spectator signage is restricted for the general public, unless they sign on at race control. Spectators are required to always stay a minimum of 3 meters away from the marked track and are not permitted in areas outside corners.

PARKING

REFUELING

Enviromats (not available at the event) must be used when replenishing any fluids, penalties will apply for non-compliance. Refueling only in designated refueling area.

(Penalty is exclusion). **ALL RIDERS MUST DISMOUNT FROM THE BIKE BEFORE REFUELLING AND ENGINES MUST BE STOPPED**

ATTENTION ALL RIDERS

As per the MOMS the use of goggle tear offs at off-road events is banned as they are not biodegradable and are harmful to the environment, native animals, and stock.



SOUND TESTING

Sound testing will take place as per the 2024 MOM Section 12:15 and appendix C, machines over 112dBA+tolerance. 2dBA before race and 3dBApost race may be excluded from the days racing at clerk of course discretion.

SCRUTINEERING

If you have not completed the scrutineering form online you MUST bring your bike to sign on for manual Scrutineering

TRANSPONDER TIMING

Transponder hire is done at time of entry however extras may be available at sign in. If sign in is closed, please see Daniel Deagan (timing) or the Clerk of Course on the day. Transponder brackets will be available for sale at sign in.

CATERING

**Catering will be available Saturday and Sunday breakfast and lunch.
Saturday night dinner available to purchase at the track.**

RIDERS BRIEFING (is COMPULSORY)

All riders (parent and guardians if under 18 years) must attend, there will be a random roll call, any competitor not present may be fined or worse.

No animals or minibikes (except those entered) are permitted at the event
